WESTON – The donation of \$5,000 to Weston's Saling House Committee at the Chamber of Commerce dinner here Wednesday night brought an audible gasp from the audience of about 100 persons.

The contribution was made by Mrs. Frances Schrimpf, Weston.

The Saling House is an 1880-vintage, pioneer home that a committee of Weston citizens use as a museum to stave off its possible destruction.

Fundraising earlier by the committee were sufficient to cover the \$4,000 down payment on the historic home, but an additional remained to be raised to complete the sale. In addition, thousands of dollars will be needed for the restoration of the home.
